Move to block threat of riot

NEWARK, N. J. — Newark was a beehive of activity all day Tuesday as leaders representing many organizations visited the offices of Mayor Hugh Addonizio and Police Director Dominick Spina to firm up plans to prevent what threatened to be a Harlem-type riot scheduled for Wednesday night.

The cause of the action was due to a meeting scheduled fro 7 o'clock Wednesday night in the heart of a housing project. The meeting was announced as designed to protest police brutality.

Police said they had information that the same leftwing militant leaders of the Harlem and Brooklyn outbreaks were in the city to foment the Newark holocaust.

The city has been flooded with inflammatory handbills urging residents of the Third Ward to attend Wednesday night's meeting.
