The information submitted herewith is our best estimate of the ammunition expenditure by type and calibre during the operation:

Ammunition Expended

Calibre .30 Rifle - - - - -	10,198 rounds
Calibre .30 Carbine - - - - -	200 rounds
Calibre .45 Pistol - - - - -	16 rounds
Total	<u>10,414 rounds</u>
