You are very naive in believing that since Newark has been so silent, since no trouble has started in Newark in the past few years, with the riots going on in New York, other areas in this very state, inLos Angeles, in the South, all over the country, but, yet, Newark has sat by quietly.

Baby, it is like the quiet before the storm. When that storm comes it is going to be a big one. It is going to be disastrous. I don't want to see it, gentlemen, but this is what we are asking for.

The black people are sick, tired and angry at the old structure that has suppressed and enslaved them for over 300 years. So you think if it happens, you can turn the National Guards on them, on us, but, gentlemen, when revolt comes and bloodshed will accompany a revolt, will it not be justified?
