I, Louise Moss, being of full age and duly sworn upon my oath, do depose and say:

1. I am a black female 27 years of age. I live at 240 Livingston Street, Newark, New Jersey, with my husband, Emerson Moss, and our children. My husband and I have been married for eleven years.

2. On July 14, 1967, at about & P.M. our family, including myself; my husband, Emerson; our sons, Eddie, 10, Clarence, 9, Michael, 6, and Jerry, 4; and my husband's brother, James Cannon, left home to go to the White Castle restaurant on Hawthorne Avenue, Newark.

3. As we were on our way, I suddenly saw armed men in uniform, in the street, I became frightened.

4. My husband slowed the car but then quickly swerved, around the men after they began shooting at our car.

5. My husband kept driving until we got home. When we got home, I discovered that my 10 year old son, Eddie, was dead, shot in the head.
