PRINCIPLES OF NACR

1. We are not a partisan political organization, and we will not tolerate extremist causes, or bigotry of any kind.
2. We believe in our constitution, our flag, and our nation 100%.
3. We advocate the right of privacy and the right to be free of all governmental compulsion based upon social, political and economic preferences which are not our own.
4. We affirm the rights of all persons to individual identification, social, religious, or ethnic preferences, and we deplore and oppose any laws or rules which compel association or affiliation based upon compliance with such laws.
5. We believe in the right of self-protection for all citizens, especially the right of police and firemen to be protected in the performance of their duties, which are so vital to the protection of life and property.
6. We deplore all violence in the false name of social action, which seeks to undermine our laws, intimidate our racial origins, threaten our lives and property, and destroy the cohesiveness of our national life. Such violence must be dealt with swiftly and to the full measure of the law.
7. We believe that law and order, and equal justice should prevail regardless of race, creed, or religion; and that special legal considerations based upon race, creed, or religion are morally wrong and destructive to our American way of life.
8. We demand a more equitable system of taxation to eliminate the burden of the home owner.
9. We demand a proportionment of welfare cases in our city, and the establishment of a 1 year residency requirement for such city welfare, even if it means circumventing the Federal Aid to dependent children clause.
10. We demand a drastic curbing of the thousands of illegitimate children born hopelessly each year. The states fornication law must be applied. God bless these innocent children. They didn't ask for these conditions.
