Presents the following Resolution:

WHEREAS, the Economic Opportunity Act of 1964 encourages the establishment of nonprofit community organizations for the purpose of developing Community Action Programs to effectuate the purposes of the Act; and

WHEREAS, representatives of the Governing Body of the City of Newark, the Board of Education of the City of Newark and members of Civic and Communal Agencies have organized the United Community Corporation as a nonprofit corporation designed to develop and administer Community Action Programs contemplated under the provisions of the Economic Opportunity Act of 1964 for the citizens of the City of Newark; and

WHEREAS, this United Community Corporation will enable the citizens of Newark to receive substantial benefits under the provisions of the Economic Opportunity Act of 1964; and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Council of the City of Newark is of the opinion that the said corporation because of its representative constituency will be in a position to formulate Community Action Programs under the Economic Opportunity Act acceptable to the appropriate Federal Authorities and to the benefit of the citizens of the City of Newark; and

WHEREAS, in order to properly organize the United Community Corporation and to provide for the necessary staff to prepare for the application of Federal funds under provisions of the Act; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education and the Welfare Federation of the City of Newark have endorsed the said United Community Corporation and committed themselves to appropriate funds to provide for the cost of administration of the said corporation; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City of Newark to participate in the said United Community Corporation; and

WHEREAS, an emergency has arisen in the Mayor's Office and Agencies, Mayor's Office, with respect to making funds available in the amount of \$15,000. as its share towards providing for the above recited services of the United Community Corporation and no adequate provision was made in the 1964 Budget for the aforesaid purpose, and R.S. 40A:4-46 provides for the creation of an emergency appropriation for the purpose above mentioned; and

WHEREAS, the total amount of emergency appropriation created including the appropriation to be created by this resolution is..... \$ 669,193.00 and three per cent of the total operating appropriation in the budget for the year 1964 is..... \$1,897,404.73

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEWARK, NEW JERSEY (no less than two-thirds of all members thereof affirmatively concurring) that in accordance with R.S. 40A:4-48,

1. An emergency appropriation be made and the same is hereby made for

2. That said emergency appropriation shall be provided in full in the 1965 budget.
3. That the statement required by the Local Government Board has been filed with the Clerk and a copy thereof will be transmitted to the Director of Local Government.
4. That one certified copy of this resolution be filed with the Director of Local Government.
