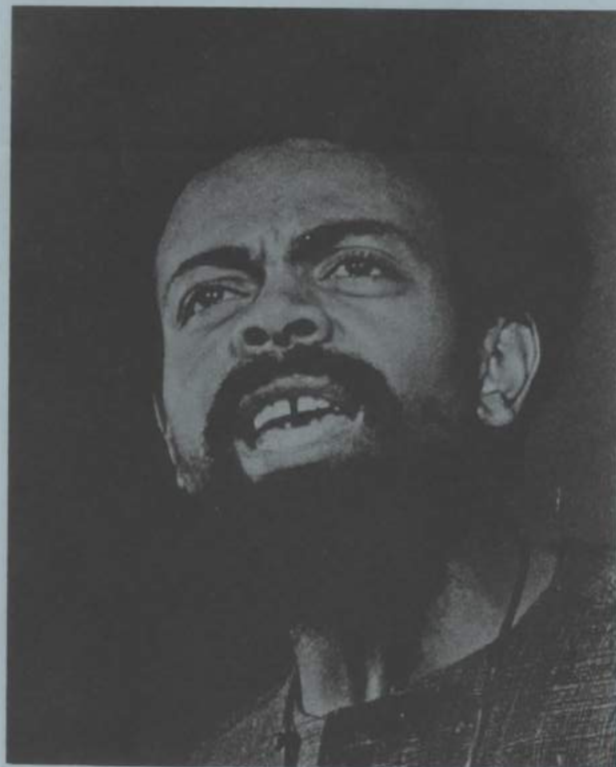

CONGRESS OF AFRIKAN PEOPLE

Cadre Organizations

Cadres make up the base of the Congress of Afrikan People. The daily work of CAP is carried out by the cadres based in cities throughout the U.S. Political Council members are elected from the Central Council Ideological training sessions conducted by the School of Kawaïda are held periodically for the cadres and twice yearly Cadre Leadership Meetings are called.

Cadres organize locally through Ideology, Organization, Communications, and Resources. Continuous weekly classes are held to supplement the ideological materials sent from the Chairman's Office. Organizational structures are moving toward standardization. Cadres make weekly contact with the Chairman's Office and biweekly newspaper Unity & Struggle is contributed to, read, and distributed by CAP cadres.

The ideology of the Congress of Afrikan People contains the three revolutionary components of our struggle for liberation: Nationalism, Pan-Afrikanism, and Socialism (Ujamaa). These are the cutting edges of our developing, ever adapting, ideology. They create Black people as a self determining, international entity struggling for a new world social order.

The Congress of Afrikan People accepts only organizational membership applications.

A) A letter requesting CAP organizational membership must be sent to the Chairman. This request should include a resume of the leader(s), a description of what your organization has done, what kind of facilities, operating programs, etc.

B) The Chairman's Office will answer with an indepth letter explaining the ideology, structure, and programs of CAP.

C) An on-site inspection by a representative of the Chairman will be scheduled and take place.

D) An inspection report will be submitted to the Political Council of CAP.

With the approval of the Political Council an organization becomes a Congress of Afrikan People cadre.

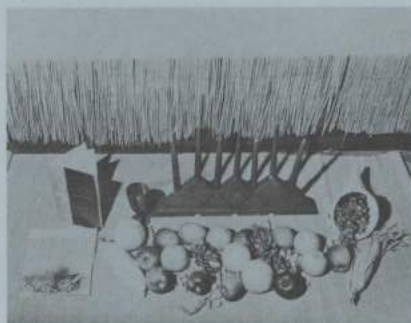

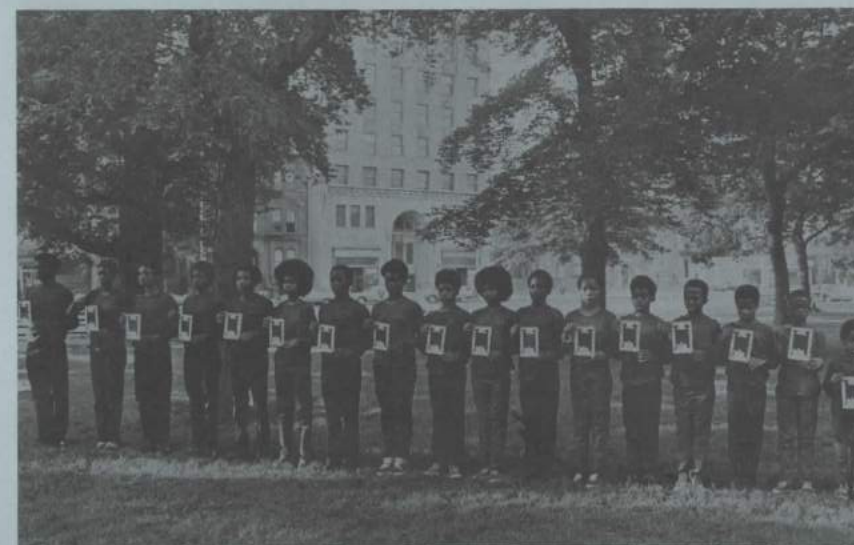
